### **SPF PORTFOLIO**

The SPF portfolio will be run on similar lines to 2020 with all entries in a DPI format. Entries have to be registered by 15th July 2021. There will be 3 categories:- Digital projected images (DPI), Mono Print and Colour Print.

Each entrant can submit unto 4 images in each category (total 12). All images are to be submitted through the Club's Competition Secretary, Alan Clark. and in a DPI format. Full details and rules are available on the SPF website.

The fee for individual entries is £0.70 per image and the fee for a Club entry is £2.00. A Club entry will consist of 4 Mono prints, 4 Colour Prints and 4 DPIs with a maximum of 2 images per author in each category.

Ian Monk is looking for members to submit up to 10 photographs for the members gallery. Images should be in jpg format, sRGB colour space and no larger than 1600px by 1200px. Watermarking and/or copywriting submitted images is recommended.
